Summer Tax Deferment Guidelines

Summer taxes can be deferred until February 14, 2025. Option 1: Household income cannot exceed \$40,000. You must be over 62 and meet specific requirements. Option 2: Agricultural Real Property. Please visit our website or call for further information. Applications MUST be received by 09/16/2024

For cost savings, summer tax receipts are generated along with the Winter tax receipts and mailed after winter tax payment is made. If a separate summer tax receipt is needed, please contact the Treasurer's Office.
