- Be sure to check the Township website for any updates or new department information.

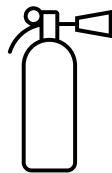
Thank you to all the volunteers who attended spring clean-up! Without you, this wouldn't have been such a success!

- The final day to pay summer taxes without interest is Monday September 14, 2026. **(The office will be open 9:00am-5:00pm this day)**. The last day for summer deferrals is Tuesday September 15, 2026.
- Payments are accepted in person, by mail, or the drop box located by the flagpole. **(POST MARKS ARE NOT ACCEPTED)**.
